Complete the micro-credentials individually or share the learning with a team. As an added benefit, we have 20+ bundles of micro-credentials that can be completed to earn a licensure renewal credit (LRC). There are currently two bundles available specifically for special education:

- **Understanding & Supporting Learners Who Face Challenges - 2 micro-credentials**
